**Background Information \*** The Doh regularly reviews MBS and implements changes based on a range of stakeholder engagement and best practice advice from the industry.

Below are changes that are being implemented from July 1st 2024:

**1) Otolaryngology and diagnostic audiology changes**

**Issue, Explanation & Recommendation #1 \***

**1) Otolaryngology and diagnostic audiology changes**

Effective 1 July 2024 there will be two new MBS items:

- 41768 and 41769 for the unilateral and bilateral insertion of a bioabsorbable implant to treat nasal airway obstruction that has occurred due to lateral wall insufficiency. These MBS will be Type C procedures which are procedures that do not normally require hospital treatment (i.e. they are outpatient procedures and if they are to be admitted will require a valid Type C certificate in line with legislation). The DoH has indicated that there will be a prosthetic item listed on the 1st July 2024 Prescribed List that will be used for these two new MBS items.

- MBS Item 11300 will be amended to remove co-claiming restrictions with items 11340, 11341 and 11343.

- Items 11340, 11341 and 11343 will be amended to remove the co-claiming restriction with item 11300
